

Kwang-Sup Soh, PhD

Dr Kwang Sup Soh was a professor of the Department of Physics and Astronomy at the Seoul National University from 1979 to 2011, where he made and led the Biomedical Physics Laboratory. He is now the Director of Nano Primo Research Center, Advanced Institute of Convergence Technolgy, Seoul National University which he established in March 2011. Professor Soh graduated from the Seoul National University (B.Sc Physic, 1968) and the Brown University (1974) where he earned a PhD in High Energy Physics. He continued his research as a Research Associate of Cornell University, USA. In 1976 he was invited to join the Agency for Defense Development of Korea and for three years Professor Soh served the country as a Senior Researcher.

An active member of both national and international professional Societies, Professor Soh served as Chairman of the Division of Elementary Particle Physics for the Korean Physical Society from 1997 to 1999. He is a current member of the American Physical Society and American Association of Anatomists. Currently he is the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Acupuncture Meridian Studies (JAMS).

Professor Soh has authored or coauthored more than 40 journal papers on primo vascular system and made numerous invited lectures nationally and internationally.

He has received various awards and honors including Science and Technology Medal of Merit from Korean Government in 2003, Heo-Jun Award for the Acupuncture Meridian Studies in 2008 and 2009 consecutively.
